

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

What to tell the driver:

1) *If you are checking into your hotel* inform the driver that your destination is the University of Utah's **Guest House**.

2) *If you are staying in the dorms or heading straight to the conference without checking-in to the hotel,* inform the driver that your destination is the University of Utah's **Heritage Center**.

**Please note: all events pertaining to the conference are located at the University of Utah in the old Fort Douglas. Registration and all of our meetings, panels, and plenary sessions are in or around the Heritage Center which is walking distance from the hotel and dorms.*

Cabs

Cost: Approximately \$20--\$26 each way. We recommend that you share a cab. Taxi service booths are located in the bag claim areas outside of door #7 in Terminal #1 and door #11 in Terminal #2.

Rental Cars

Alamo, Avis, Budget, Dollar, Hertz and National rental car companies are located on the lowest level of the airport's parking terrace (across from passenger pick up #4). For more information visit: <http://www.saltlakecityutah.org/carrentals.htm>.

Ground Transportation

A UTA bus leaves the airport every 30 minutes during the day and every 60 minutes after 7:00 pm. One-way fare is \$1.60. Bus stops are located in the parking structure between Terminal One and Terminal Two. Limited service is available on weekends and holidays. Hours of Operation: 6:00 am–11:00 pm Monday-Saturday and 9:45 am–10:00 pm Sunday and holidays. For more information, visit: <http://www.rideuta.com> or call (801) 575-2477.

If riding the bus, directions:

- 1) Board **Route #550 Airport to Intermodal Center** (ask for a bus transfer as you board)
- 2) Get off at stop located at **200 South @ 148 West**
- 3) Walk to stop located at **Main Street @ 255 South**
- 4) Board **University TRAX Line (light rail) Eastbound**
- 5) Get off at stop **Fort Douglas**

6) Cross bridge to Guest House or Heritage Center

Total time: 58 minutes to an hour

Driving Directions to the Heritage Center

From the West/Airport

- From the airport take the left exit marked Salt Lake/Provo/Ogden
- Go left to City Center East I-80.
- Exit at exit 121—600 South. You will be traveling east
- Head east on 600 South to 700 East
- Turn left (north) on 700 East and go two blocks to 400 South
- Turn right (east) on 400 South and follow until Mario Capecchi Dr (400 S. will turn into 500 S.)
- At Mario Capecchi Dr. turn left (north)
- See “**Final Directions to the Heritage Center**”

From the North

- Travel south on I-15 to the 400 South (4th South) exit
- Turn left at the bottom of the off-ramp—you will be heading east on 400 South
- Follow 400 South until you reach Mario Capecchi Dr. (400 South will turn into 500 South)
- At Mario Capecchi Dr. turn left (north)
- See “**Final Directions to the Heritage Center**”

From the South

- Travel north on I-15 to the 600 South Exit
- Head east on 600 South to 700 East
- Turn left (north) on 700 East and go two blocks to 400 South
- Turn right (east) on 400 South and follow until Mario Capecchi Dr (400 S. will turn into 500 S.)
- At Mario Capecchi Dr. turn left (north)
- See “**Final Directions to the Heritage Center**”

From the East/Park City

- Travel west on I-80
- Exit at Foothill Drive (also says University of Utah)
- Follow Foothill Drive to Mario Capecchi Dr.
- Turn right on Mario Capecchi (heading north)
- See “**Final Directions to the Heritage Center**”

Final Directions to the Heritage Center

- Travel one block to South Campus Drive, and turn right (South Campus Drive will turn into Hempstead Rd).
- Follow Hempstead Rd. until you arrive to the stop, once at the stop continue straight to access the parking lot that is in front.
- The large brick building to the northeast of the parking lot is the Heritage Center; follow the signs that will be placed along the sidewalk to direct you to this building.

WHAT TO BRING?

Caution: Salt Lake City is 4,300 feet above sea level and temperatures around this time of year can be between 90 to 100 degrees (very low humidity). Due to the heat and elevation, you may initially feel light headed, tired, sleepy, and/or constant thirst. If you are staying in the dorms please note that these items are provided: one blanket, pillow, sheets, pillow case, towel (small), toilet paper, one cup, one small bar of soap, and internet accessibility.

We recommend:

- Drinking **plenty** of water
- Wearing sunscreen
- Insect repellent if you go to the mountains or a park in the evening
- Sunglasses
- Casual and light clothing items
- Comfortable walking shoes (the University has plenty of inclines)
- Light sweater or jacket for inside air conditioning
- Hat/cap
- Consume alcohol **cautiously** as it has more effect at this altitude!
